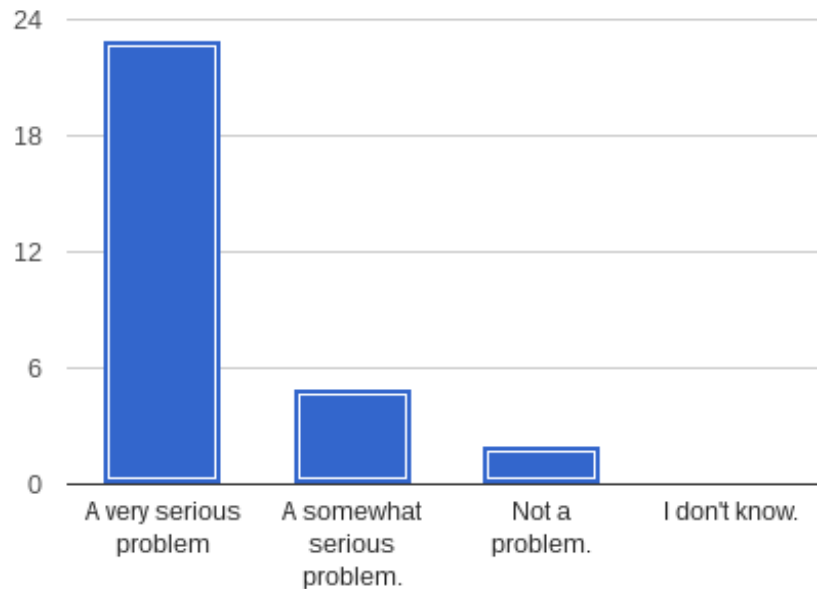
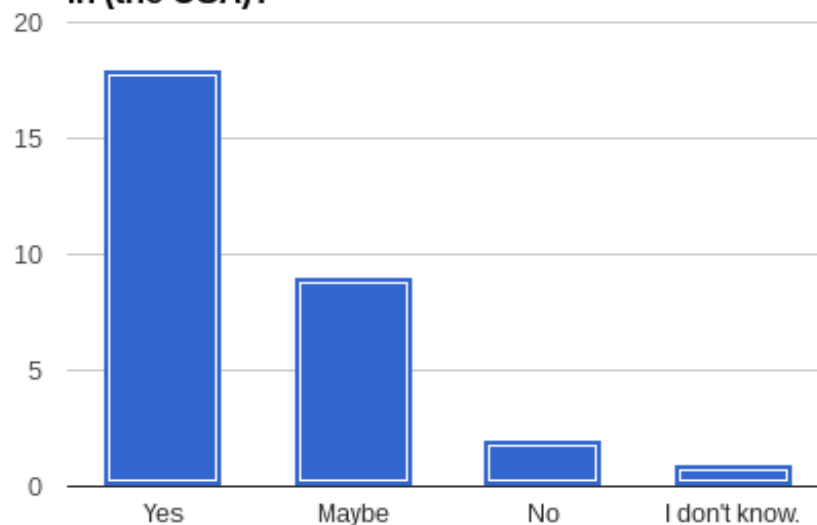

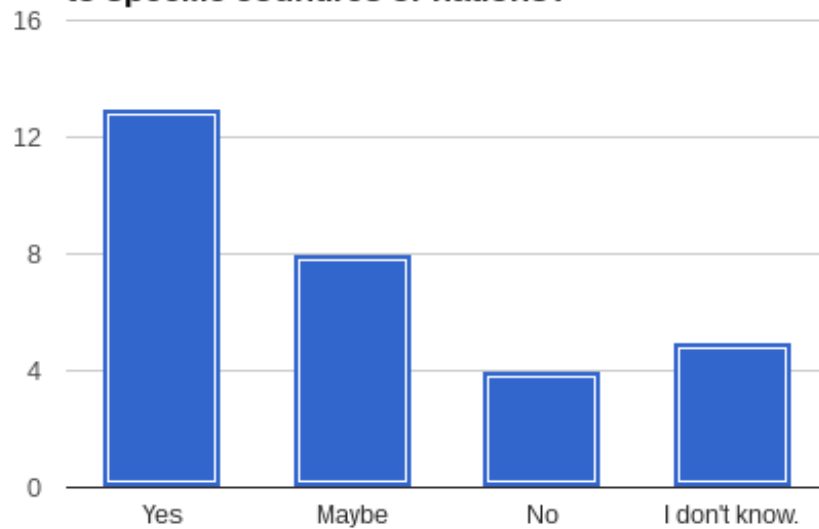
Question 1 : How much do you think terrorism is a problem all around the world today?



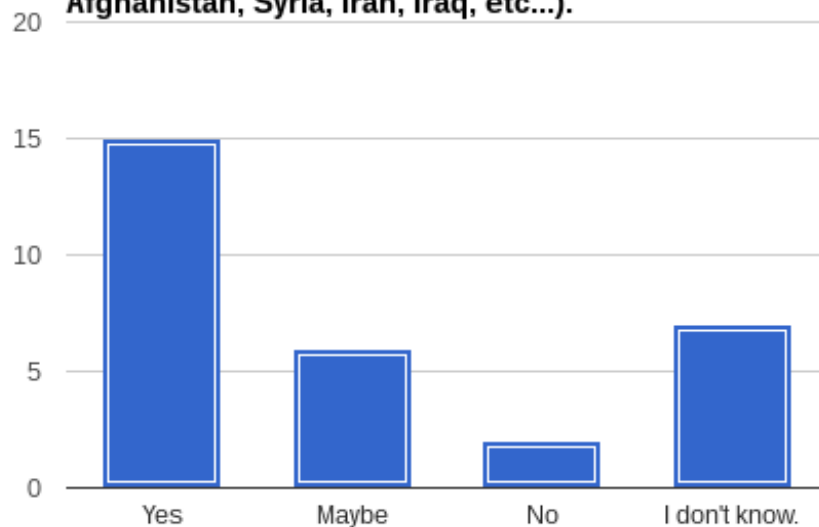
Question 2 : Do you agree that terrorism is viewed as a major issue on the country you are in (the USA)?



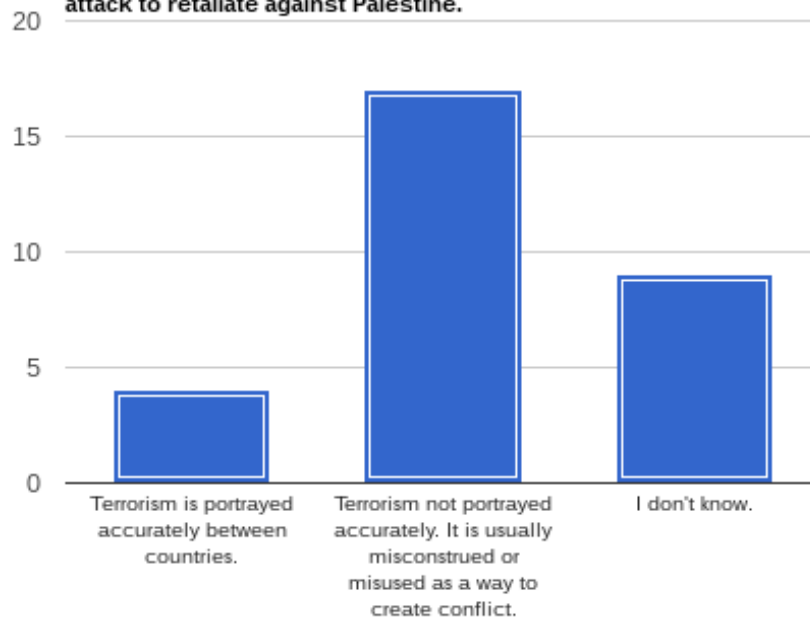
Question 3 : Do you think it's plausible (reasonable) that terrorist groups can be linked to specific countries or nations?



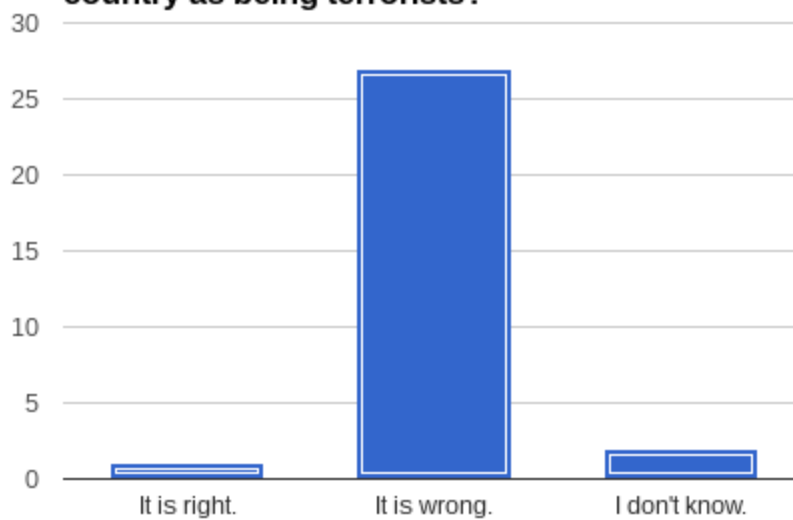

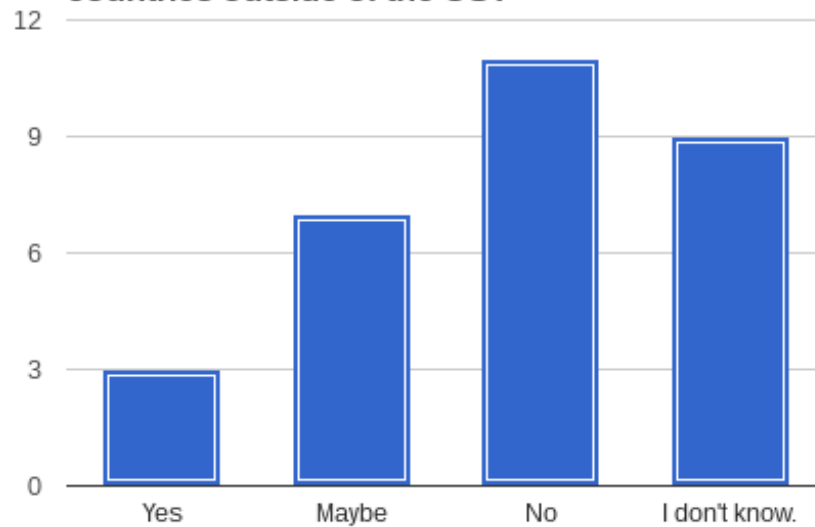

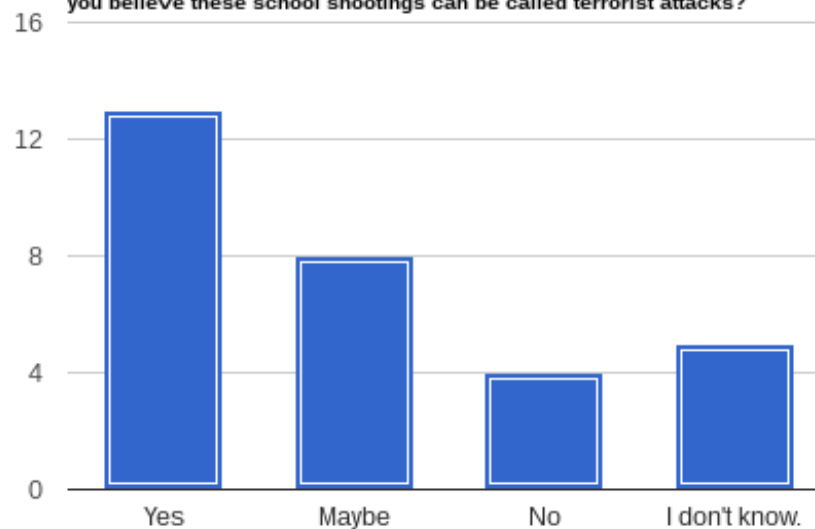
Question 6 : Do you believe that it is right or wrong to characterize all people from one country as being terrorists?
